

**Minutes of the meeting of State Executive Committee held on 1st November 2016 for
examination of SDRF proposals.**

The meeting was chaired by the Chief Secretary, Assam & Chairman State Executive Committee (SEC).

Agenda Item: 1. Confirmation of minutes of the 27th SEC meeting

Resolution: SEC confirmed the minutes of the 27th SEC meeting held on 6th October 2016 and also approved the items placed in the Additional agenda Item .

Agenda Item: 2. SDRF proposals of Water Resource Department

Resolution After detailed discussion the SEC approved the following **26** proposals amounting to Rs.**48.8472 crore**. Regarding the proposal of Majuli at Sl. No.1 in the list below, the approval has been accorded subject to TAC approval.

SEC directed ASDMA to return the 29 proposals as enclosed at **Annexure-II**, to the Department for resubmission.

Out of 159 proposals, 104 proposals did not meet SDRF Norms and hence, rejected by the SEC.

AGENDA ITEM NO 3: SDRF PROPOSALS OF PWD ROADS DEPARTMENT

Resolution: SEC directed ASDMA to return the 8 proposals amounting to Rs. 832.62 lakh of PWD Roads to the department as they do not meet SDRF Norms.

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AGENDA ITEM NO 4: SDRF PROPOSALS OF SOIL CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT

Resolution: SEC directed ASDMA to return the proposal of Soil Conservation Department viz. "Immediate Measure to restore, strengthening and stabilisation of landslide prone area in the hillocks of Guwahati City under SDRF for 2016-17" amounting to Rs 5990.14 lakh to the Department as it does not fit in to the SDRF norms.

AGENDA ITEM NO 5: SDRF PROPOSALS OF IRRIGATION DEPARTMENT

Resolution: SEC directed ASDMA to return the 19 nos. of SDRF proposals amounting to Rs. 14.63 Crore of Irrigation department for the year 2016-17 for resubmission with clearly stating the extent of damages & what it proposes to restore.

AGENDA ITEM NO 6: SDRF PROPOSALS OF EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

Resolution: SEC directed ASDMA to return the proposal of Education Department viz. "Restoration of Pachim Jalukbari Prathamik Vidlaya (Building No-2)" amounting to Rs. 8.864 lakh, as the proposal is for 2015-16 damage and therefore, does not meet SDRF norms.

AGENDA ITEM NO 7: SDRF PROPOSALS OF GMC (GDD)

Resolution: Regarding the SDRF proposals of GMC, SEC took the following resolutions:

1. ASDMA will seek the views of the Finance Department regarding the admissibility of the proposals for de-siltation of major channels / Drains of GMC for Rs. 2786.00 lakh .
2. SEC approved 10 numbers of Dewatering Pumps for Rs. 55.40 lakh under 10% of SDRF subject to observing due procedures.
3. Water Resource Department to submit a DPR for doubling the Pumping Capacity of Bharalu pumping Station.

AGENDA ITEM NO 8: Creation of SDRF Cell

Resolution: Chief Secretary & Chairperson SEC directed ASDMA to maintain status-quo and directed Revenue & DM Department to provide additional manpower in terms of deputation of engineers from Water Resource Department, PWD Roads and Irrigation Department.



ADDITIONAL AGENDA:

1. Formation and Training of WDMCs and VLMCCs

Resolution: SEC reconsidered the earlier decision and agreed to approve the going ahead with the training of VLMCC and also formation and orientation of WDMC without the NRC condition by the Revenue Officials.


2. Co-ordinates of VGRs for GIS mapping

Resolution: SEC reconsidered the earlier decision and directed ASDMA to support the Revenue & DM Department in its work for VGR & PGR Mapping if authenticated data is received from the districts.

3. Project on Village land use Maps in collaboration with NESAC

Resolution: SEC took note of the appraisal note that ASDMA is preparing the utility maps for 90 villages and will also prepare the land use map for these villages in-house. Further, land use maps of 5 villages is already complete.
