A Meeting on "DEVELOPMENT OF ACTION PLAN ON CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SCHOOL SAFETY" was held under the chairmanship of Shri. Rajib Prakash Baruah, Addl. Secretary & SPC, ASDMA. The Administrative Officer and officials of ASDMA and senior representatives from Education Department (Elementary & Secondary), Health Department and representatives from SSA, RMSA, Fire & Emergency Services, Assam, and Indian Red Cross Society were also present in the meeting.

The National School Safety Policy guidelines were discussed in details in the meeting and a presentation was made on the policy.

After detailed discussions on the agenda points, following resolutions were taken:

Agenda 1:

Responsibility of Education Department on School Safety measures:

- 1. Education Department will provide ASDMA with the District wise data of School Teachers to be nominated as "School Safety Focal Point Teacher (SFPT)", as per National School Safety Policy guideline.
- 2. Education Department will take initiative for inclusion of School Safety policy measures in post and pre-service training of Teachers through the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET).
- 3. SSA and RMSA will ensure preparation of "School Disaster Management Plans (SDMP)" as per School DM Plan Template of National School Safety Policy guideline in all schools.
- 4. Education Department will take initiative for inclusion of Disaster Management topics in monthly "Cluster Resource Co-ordinator (CRC)" meetings and ensure presence of "School Safety Focal Point Teacher (SFPT) in the CRC meetings.
- 5. Education department will take measures to nominate a group of "Peer Educators/Trainers" in schools for ensuring that safety messages, dos and don'ts of different disasters, procedures and protocols, reach each and every student in the school. Active Student Members from the sub-committees under School DM committee (SDMC) can be nominated as Peer Educators.
- 6. List of sub-committees to be constituted by Education department in schools as per National School Safety Policy Guideline are-
 - Awareness generation and warning and information dissemination team.
 - Evacuation team.
 - Search and rescue team (only teachers to be member of this team)
 - Fire safety team
 - First aid team
 - Bus safety team (for each bus)
 - Site security team
- 7. Education Department will submit an "Action Plan" to ASDMA for the Capacity Building of Teachers, SMC members and Peer Groups etc. as per National School Safety Policy Guideline

Agenda 2

Responsibility of SDRF for Awareness generation and Capacity Building

- 8. Fire & Emergency will submit an "Action Plan" on School Mock Drills at Block Level.
- 9. Fire & Emergency will submit a "State School Fire Safety Management Plan" with inclusion of provisions as per the National School Safety Policy Guideline.

Agenda 3

Responsibility of Health Deptt. & Redcross Society for First Aid Training for School Children.

- 10. Health Department will notify the Multi-Purpose Workers (MPW) for ToT on First Aid to be provided by Indian Red Cross Society.
- 11. Multi-Purpose Workers (MPW) will provide First Aid Trainings for Peer Educators in Schools.
- 12. IRCS will submit to ASDMA -Guidelines for formation of Junior Red Cross Unit in Schools.
- 13. Health Deptt. & Red-Cross Society will submit to ASDMA, a joint action plan for First Aid trainings in schools.

Agenda 4

- 14. ASDMA will provide soft copies of IEC materials to the Education department. The Education department will print the IEC with their available budget and distribute in schools.
- 15. ASDMA will develop a "JOINT ACTION PLAN FOR CAPACITY BUILDING UNDER SCHOOL SAFETY GUIDELINE" on the basis of "Action Plan" submitted by the stakeholder department viz. Education, Health, IRCS and Fire & Emergency Services.
